Reporting options include a robust set of standard reports, powerful tools for custom reporting, and data formats conducive to industry-standard, off-the-shelf reporting applications.

Financial reports include both standard reports and custom reporting tools to automate revenue cycle monitoring and analysis across your organization.

Standard financial reports include:

- Operational reports and executive summaries
- A/R & collection reports
- Transaction and diagnosis reports
- Month end reports
- Reimbursement reports

In addition to standard reports, ad hoc (on-the-fly) and custom reporting options help organizations monitor and optimize performance on every level. Likewise, financial data can be sent to Data Repository for enterprise-level reporting and optional third-party business intelligence.

### Meet ARRA/Meaningful Use Requirements

The ambulatory reporting functionality within Medical and Practice Management goes well beyond simply providing the tools necessary to capture data. It includes robust "best practices" documentation covering all ARRA Meaningful Use requirements. Utilization reports are pre-built in the system for all core and menu set measures and can be quickly activated and deployed with routine parameter changes. Medical and Practice Management's clinical quality reporting tools support more than 30 quality measures and allow users to develop their own numerator and denominator calculations to meet Meaningful Use requirements.

### Leverage Advanced Reporting Tools

Utilizing Data Repository, organizations can generate and analyze information from all care settings across the continuum, including practices and clinics. Ambulatory data may also be segregated and reported upon at the physician group, department, and practice level. Data Repository features include:

- An industry-standard Microsoft Windows operating system and Microsoft SQL Server® Relational Database Management System
- Common identifiers between ambulatory and acute applications to reliably index and cross-reference information
- Continuous or batch transfer options to support timely reporting
- Additional integration with MEDITECH's financial applications, including General Ledger, Accounts Payable, and Executive Support System
- Support for popular off-the-shelf software, including Microsoft® Excel, Microsoft® Access, and Crystal Reports.®

Customers may also work with Medisolv, a third-party vendor that develops reporting tools designed to work with MEDITECH's Data Repository, including sophisticated dashboards and data analysis tools.
